# Insect Winsey Spider

Move your spider up the drainpipe in this Orchard Toys classic by counting or matching shapes, but watch out for the rain which will wash you back down again!

**Contents**

- 4 double-sided drainpipe boards • 4 spider playing pieces and stands • 1 spinner • 1 number dice • 1 shapes dice • 1 dice shaker

**Setting up the Shapes Game**

Assemble the boards and place them, shape side up, on the table with the spinner, dice shaker and shape dice. Each player chooses a matching coloured spider and arrange board and places their spider on the start space at the bottom of the drainpipe.

**1 Roll the dice**

The youngest player starts. Roll the dice.

**2 Match the shape**

Move your spider up the drainpipe to the first shape that matches the shape shown on the dice.

**3 Spin the spinner**

If the umbrella points to the sun, your spider stays where it is. Play passes to the next player. If the umbrella points to the rain cloud, your spider is washed down the drainpipe back to the start. Play passes to the next player.

**4 The winner**

The first player to get their spider to the top of their drainpipe is the winner.

**Playing the Counting Game**

Set up as Shapes Game, but place the boards shape side down and only use the number dice. Play as Shapes Game, but move your spider up your drainpipe the number of spaces indicated by the number dice. You do not need to roll the exact number to reach your web.

Only use the shape dice when using the counting game.

When using the counting game, the dice shaker and dice are not used. The spinner is used to determine the player's order. The spinner is used to determine who plays first.

**Quick Start**

Roll the dice and move up the drainpipe.

Spin the spinner

- ☀️ = stay where you are
- ☁️ = back to the start

The winner is the first player to reach their spider web.

# Money Match Café

Add up the coins and deliver your meals in this fun money game

**Contents**

- 4 3D tables • 1 spinner (expresses picnic items from the base and attach to server board) • 1 till board • 1 tray board • 16 meal/beverage/snack cards • 32 money cards (16 easy coins, 16 hard coins)

**Setting up the game**

Assemble the tables and place them on different points around the room. Sit your own toy tea at the tables to act as potential customers.

Each player is dealt four meal cards.

Spread the money cards face down on the table. Note for all water games use the green cards, for a more difficult game use the red cards. For a mixed ability group use all cards and a picture sheet.

Place the till, spinner and tray where everyone can reach them.

**1 To play**

The youngest player begins by turning over a money card.

Add up the coins and look to see whether any of the prices on your meals match the amount of coins shown on the money card.

**2 If the prices don't match**

If none of the prices match the coins on the money card, return it face down to the table. Play passes to the next player.

**3 If the prices match**

If one of your meal prices does match the coins, check to see if you are correct by turning over the meal card (the picture of the coins should look the same).

If you aren't correct return the money card face down to the table. Play passes to the next player.

However, if you are correct you can deliver your meal!

**4 Delivering your meal**

To deliver your meal, place the money card on the till, then spin the spinner to see which table you will be serving.

Now carefully put the meal on the tray and deliver it onto the relevant table. Try not to drop it on the way!

Play passes to the next player.

**5 The winner**

The game continues until one player has delivered all their meal cards. This person is the winner!

**Quick Start**

Set up the café and take four meal cards.

Take turns to match the coin cards to your meal prices.

When you find a match put your money in the till, spin the spinner and serve your meal to the relevant table.

The winner is the first person to serve all four meals to the tables!

#### Set Up

1. Remove the contents from the pack.
2. Insert a duvet into the Twister duvet cover.
3. Before play, perform any warm-up exercises that may be required.

#### How to play

1. Take turns to roll the dice and move your opponent(s) around the duvet.
2. The dice will show you the move that your opponent has to perform.
3. Once you have made your move, you must remain in that position until the dice has been rolled again.
4. The Players continue to be moved around the duvet on hands and feet, until they touch the duvet cover with a knee, elbow or any other part of the body that is deemed illegal.
5. When contact has been made, change places and continue the game.
6. If more than two players are available to play, then appoint a referee and rotate the players until everyone has had a go.

#### And the winner is...

The Player that manages to stay upright for the most number of moves.
